Okay, I'm trying to create a dll file.

It's in VS 2008, VB and set up as a com class.

I have the following code. in the .vb, and I build and register the DLL. However, the signature import routine does not give me the QBGetCustomers operation I was expecting, instead it gives me an EQUALS, and three others, and a second signature called U_OBJECT.

Does anyone know what I am missing here. Someone must have written some com code.... Please help, I'm beating my head against a wall of thousands of web-pages, all talking VB6 or .NET and (of course) none of them relating to the com interface in Uniface....
